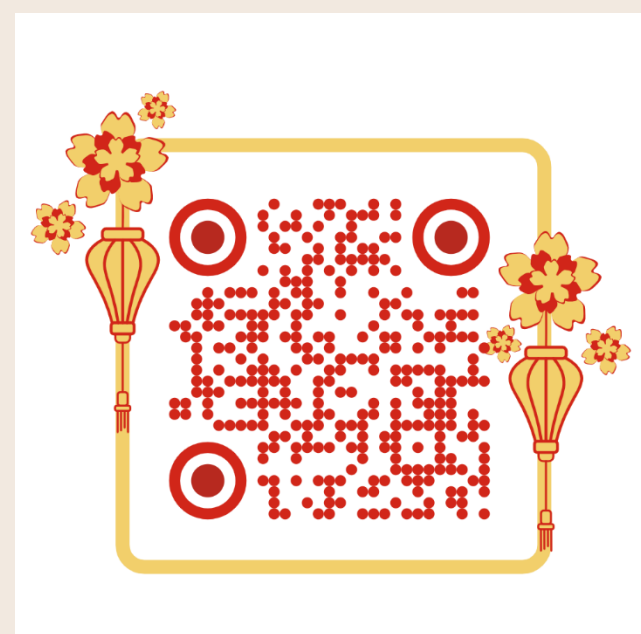

The Wine Routes go through the **3 historical wine regions** designated for the production of wines with protected geographic indication and include:

- 40 wineries for tours and wine tastings
- 6 wineries with accommodation
- 14 wineries with restaurants or food experiences
- Historical, natural and cultural attractions



The Wine Routes of Moldova are affiliated with the European Cultural Route of the Vine and Wine 'Iter Vitis - Les Chemins de la Vigne,' promoted by the European Federation Iter Vitis and certified as a 'Cultural Route of the Council of Europe.'

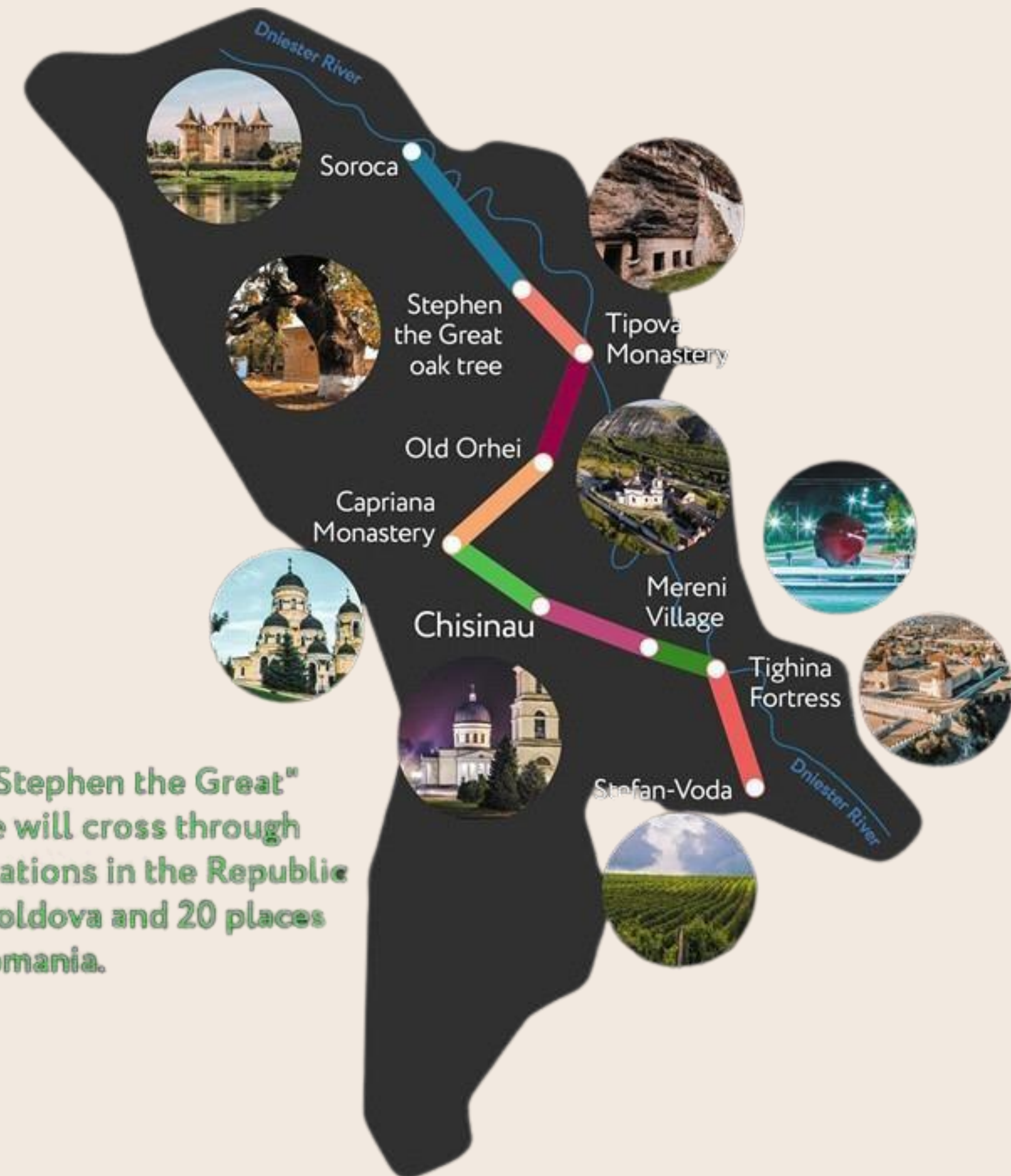

Route of Wooden Churches

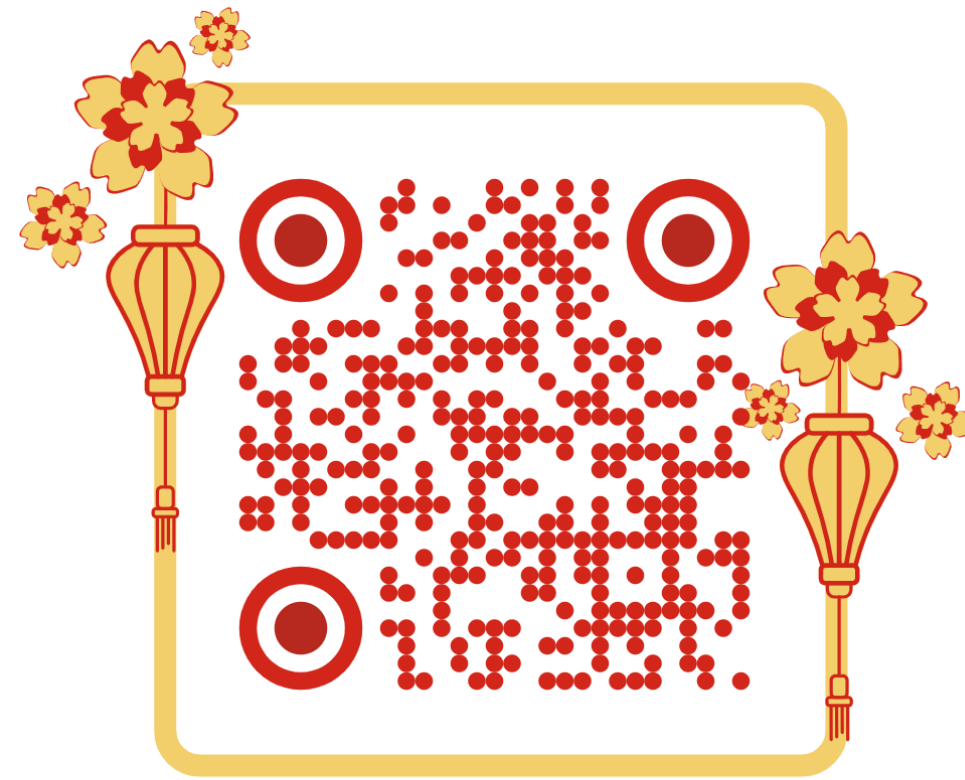


Cultural tourist rout of the Wooden churches in Romania and Moldova -

You can reach Moldova with direct flights from 46 cities:

Another option is to fly a low-cost airline to nearby Iași International Airport in Romania, which is located approximately 130 kilometers from Moldova's capital city, Chișinău. From there, it's easy to take a train or bus to reach Moldova.
